PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

On Monday morning we held our traditional school Anzac day ceremony. I would like to thank Bec Lansbury and the grade 5/6 team for the work in putting on this very important event.

Thank you to all the families that attended yesterday's ceremony, and for bringing the students in their school uniforms to represent our school as a part of this community. I know that the RSL really appreciate our interest and commemoration of such significant world events.
